Overview of the Nanjing Center

The Nanjing Center is an initiative approved by the AmCham Shanghai Board of Governors in January 2016. The goal of the Center is to promote the interests of U.S. business in Nanjing and is managed by the American Chamber of Commerce in Shanghai Yangtze River Delta Network.
